What is an eVisa?

An **eVisa** is the UK Government's digital system for managing immigration status. Instead of physical documents like Biometric Residence Permits (BRPs) or Biometric Residence Cards (BRCs), your eVisa is accessible online. It securely displays:

- **Your Name and Photo**
- **The type and duration of your leave to remain.**

This is a **Fully valid proof of immigration status** and is widely accepted in line with UK Government regulations.

Why Have Physical Immigration Cards Expired?

By **31 December 2024**, all BRPs and BRCs will expire as the UK transitions to digital systems. Importantly, the expiration of these cards does not affect your actual immigration status or rights. Your leave to remain is valid until its stated expiry date.

If you are traveling, remember:

- Airlines must allow boarding with an expired BRP or BRC until **31 March 2025**.
- If denied boarding, keep detailed records and contact the **Home Office Carriers'**

Your Rights with an eVisa

Your eVisa guarantees you the same rights as before. These include:

- **Entry and stay in the UK:** You are entitled to enter and remain in the UK as per your leave to remain. Your eVisa guarantees you the same rights as before. These include:
- **Employment:** Your eVisa confirms your right to work legally.
- **Renting:** Landlords can verify your right to rent using the share code from your eVisa account.
- **Healthcare:** Accessing NHS services remains unchanged.

If there are any disputes, request the authority to verify your status directly with the Home Office.

Tips for Traveling with Your eVisa

To make your travel seamless, **Briton Solicitors** advises you to:

- 1 Log in to your eVisa account before traveling and generate a **share code**.
Share codes are valid for 90 days and can be reused.
- 2 Carry your expired BRP/BRC and your passport (ensure your passport is linked to your eVisa).
- 3 Consider printing or saving a screenshot of your e Visa details as a backup (optional) but helpful).
